


LOCATION





Situated in the world-renowned wine region of Barossa, Barossa Central Shopping Centre is anchored by one of South Australia's largest independent supermarkets, Barossa Fresh, and 30 specialty shops.

Barossa Central is referred to as the 'meeting place of Barossa'. Based in the heart of Nuriootpa, it is the only shopping centre in the region with two large supermarkets, internal mall and free undercover car parking.

Barossa Central is a modern shopping destination, having undertaken a \$36 million development and extension in 2017.

Key regional statistics:
